The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a really positive step towards you having more control over how your company data is used and how you are contacted. The changes will also help to better protect your data.

Clients can log on to The Shipbrokers' Register on the web, www.shipreg.org and view their profile and view the data that we hold and update it at any time by getting in contact with us. The information will also be in a printed version.

By registering as a client of The Shipbrokers' Register, you consent to receiving information from The Shipbrokers' Register that is intrinsic with a membership by post, e-mail or telephone. You are able to manage what and how you receive other communications from us.

Your data will be shared with other clients, branches etc. if appropriate and to our logistic provider for the purpose of distributing our entry forms and other communications from us.

Our new Privacy Policy is effective from 25 May 2018.
